Below are the final prices per ton numbers from the 2012 Oregon Wine Production Census. Price per ton ranged from a low of \$1,029 for Müler -Thurgau to a high of \$2,704 for Pinot Noir. Price per ton changes from 2011 saw the greatest increase for White Riesling at 41.8%, followed by Pinot Blanc at 27.5%, Syrah at 23.9%, Pinot Noir at 19.1%, Pinot Gris at 18.5%, and Zinfandel at 15.4%. For Pinot Noir this price level is the highest since the 2008 vintage. While some varieties saw small declines, the Sauvignon Blanc price per ton dropped 17.8% from 2011 to 2012.

The 2012 Oregon Wine Production Census has finished collecting data and currently in the analysis stage with the final report release expected in early November.
